#### **About VMR Brisbane**

VMR Brisbane is a volunteer organisation whose primary purpose is to preserving life at sea and creating a safer marine environment for anyone enjoying fishing or watersports in Moreton Bay and surrounding areas. Affiliated with VMR Brisbane are the Sandgate Yacht Club, Sandgate Canoe Club and the Polynesian Outriggers Club.

Further, we provide facilities and assistance to various local volunteer organisations, clubs and schools. Our base is strategically located at Shorncliffe, adjacent to Brisbane Airport and the Port of Brisbane.

Our history can be traced to the foundation of the Sandgate Yacht Club in 1912 where of course, wind-powered sailing was king. It was after a sailing accident in Moreton Bay that it was decided that a group should be formed to help provide safety on the water. After fifty years of success, membership was opened to owners of power vessels. Shortly after 1969, the Sandgate Yacht Club Search and Rescue Squad was formed. The organisations name changed in 1977 and again in 1990 and we are now known as Volunteer Marine Rescue Brisbane.

As a volunteer marine rescue organisation we provide a "first response" emergency service 24 hours a day 7 days a week. Volunteer Duty Crews maintain a vessel monitoring service every weekend and public holiday. After hours calls are attended to by our Emergency Standby crew. We work closely with other emergency services organisations including Water Police, Ambulance and SES.

We currently operate three purpose-built rescue vessels. Our primary rescue vessel is a Kevlacat 3000 powered by twin 250hp Suzuki four-stroke outboards. Our most recent acquisition is a 5.9m Swift inflatable RIB powered by a 175hp Suzuki. Our third vessel is a 4.59m Stabicraft which is now primarily used for training an inshore work. The Stabicraft is powered by a 60hp Yamaha four-stroke outboard. All vessels are fitted with all the required safety equipment, radios and additional equipment necessary for operations in our area.

VMR Brisbane is predominately a self-funded organisation. We receive financial support from the State Government to cover some operational costs and capital expenditure. This financial support, although greatly appreciated, represents only a fraction of the capital requirements and operational costs required for the effective running of our Squadron. We attempt to address the funding gap through prudent financial management, membership fees, fund raising, and grants and sponsorships. We are privileged to enjoy the support of the Member for Sandgate Jared Cassidy, Brisbane City Council Member for Deagon Stirling Hinchliffe, Weather Presenter Paul Burt and the Qld Police Commissioner Ian Stewart.

### **Volunteer Duty Crew**

If you are willing to donate your time to provide a valuable community service, joining one of our Duty Crews may be for you. As mentioned earlier, the primary purpose of our organisation is to save the lives of people in distress in Moreton Bay and surrounding areas and this service is provided by our Duty Crews. Our Duty Crews attend our Operations Centre to maintain a vessel monitoring service and provide assistance as required every weekend and public holidays from 0600 hrs until 1700 hrs. Typically each Duty Crew is rostered on for one day in every four to five weeks.

New Duty Crew members must complete basic training (ESS) within six months of joining. This training includes both theory and practical learning and assessment. Fortunately, for people on the water, we are not in full-on rescue mode too often so on our Crew Day, our crews undertake practical training such as tow-jobs, navigation exercises and emergency procedures such as fire on board the vessel, man-overboard and grounding for readiness for the various search and rescue scenarios that we may encounter.

### **Membership Information**

Our members have access, from our Operations Centre, to local fishing areas which are recognised as being some of the best in the world. We have a number of membership classifications which are listed in the table below.

#### Hardstand

Eligible members may apply for a Hardstand bay for onsite vessel storage by completing and submitting Form **VMR020** Application for Hardstand Storage. When a vacancy becomes available, the applicant will be notified and the hardstand bay will be allocated upon receipt of payment. The Hardstand fee is reviewed by the Management Committee on an annual basis and all Hardstand fees are calculated on a pro-rata basis to the end of the financial year and must be paid in advance.
